This colony was started as a refuge for Quakers and was known for its fair, representative government and religious tolerance.

What is Pennsylvania?

This colony was started by Roger Williams who was displeased with the leadership of Massachusetts. He wanted to create a colony that separated the church from politics and treated Indians fairly.

\$200

What is Rhode Island?

\$300

This colony was a proprietary colony given to Sir George Carteret and John Lord Berkeley. This coastal colony occupied the land between the Delaware and Hudson Rivers.

What is New Jersey?

\$400

This colony was started by James Oglethorpe to create a haven for the poor and jailed debtors from England. This colony originally outlawed slavery and limited how much land each individual could own.

\$400

What is Georgia?

<u>\$500</u>

This colony was home to the South's largest port city, Charleston. It was also the only colony with a greater population of slaves than whites.

What is South Carolina?

\$100

This was the first profitable cash crop in the Americas

What is Tobacco?

<u>\$200</u>

In the triangular trade, name 2 things that were shipped from Africa to the West Indies (Caribbean Islands).

What are slaves, gold, or spices?

<u>\$300</u>

This terrifying leg of triangular trade from Africa to the West Indies resulted in the death of nearly one-third of all slaves on board.

What is the Middle Passage?

\$400

The practice of controlling trade to create and maintain the wealth of European nations and empires

What is mercantilism?

<u>\$500</u>

Goods protected by import duties and shipped from England to America as a part of triangular trade

What are manufactured or finished products?

This document outlined the principles of the Pilgrim colony's government.

What is the Mayflower Compact?

\$200

Laws passed specifically to control the slave population

What are Slave Codes?

\$300

Due to political, religious, and economic problems, tens of thousands of people left England and made their way to America.

\$300

What is the Great Migration?

\$400

This was the first document of its kind, guaranteeing religious freedom for all Christians in Maryland.

\$400

What was the Toleration Act of 1649?

\$500

These placed duties (taxes) on certain Colonial goods sold in Europe, and prohibited the American colonies from trading with anyone but England, severely weakening the Colony's economy.

What were the Navigation Acts?

\$100

This type of colonial charter was given to a group of investors.

\$100

What is a Company Charter?

(Joint Stock Company)

\$200

This type of charter was given to an individual or group of individuals.

What is a proprietary charter?

\$300

This type of charter was held by the monarch.

What is a royal charter?

<u>\$400</u>

These were the only two company colonies in America.

What are Virginia and Massachusetts?

<u>\$500</u>

New York was governed by this type of charter.

What is a royal charter?

\$100

This group of colonies was known as the "breadbasket" because they grew wheat, oats, grains, and raised livestock.

\$100

What are the Middle Colonies?

\$200

This group of colonies was unable to grow large amounts of any crop due to its rocky soil. Therefore, these colonies specialized in shipping, manufacturing, and fishing.

What are the New England Colonies?

\$300

This region principally grew cash crops like rice, indigo, and tobacco

Who are the Southern Colonies?

\$400

Because of the large number of plantations that scattered the landscape, this region had a higher slave population than the others

\$400

What were the Southern colonies?

<u>\$500</u>

One might say that this group of colonies was more religiously focused than the others, because three of its colonies were founded by ministers or religious groups
