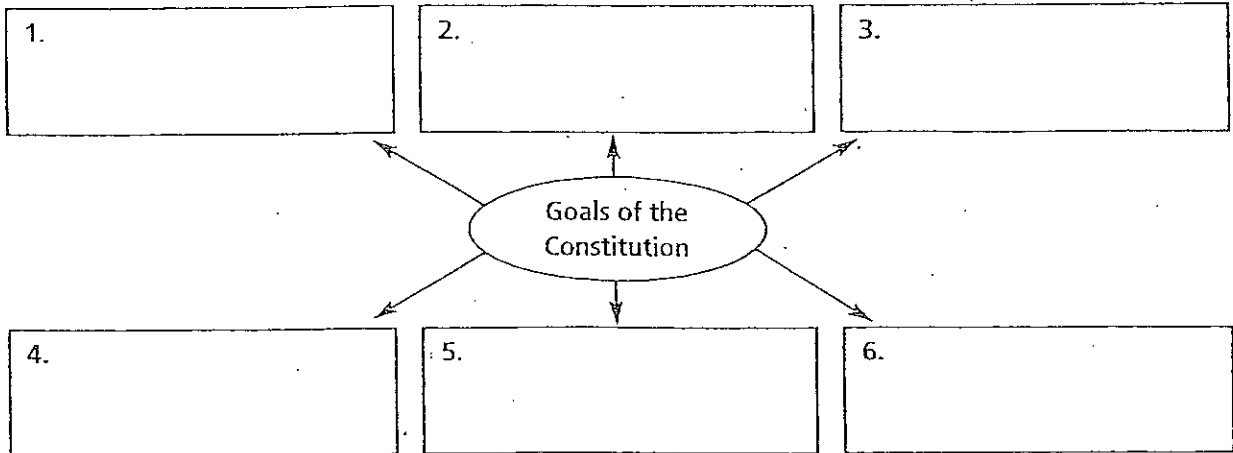


U.S. Constitution: Preamble & Article I

Preamble: States the purposes for writing the Constitution. Complete the cluster diagram with the six goals of the Constitution.

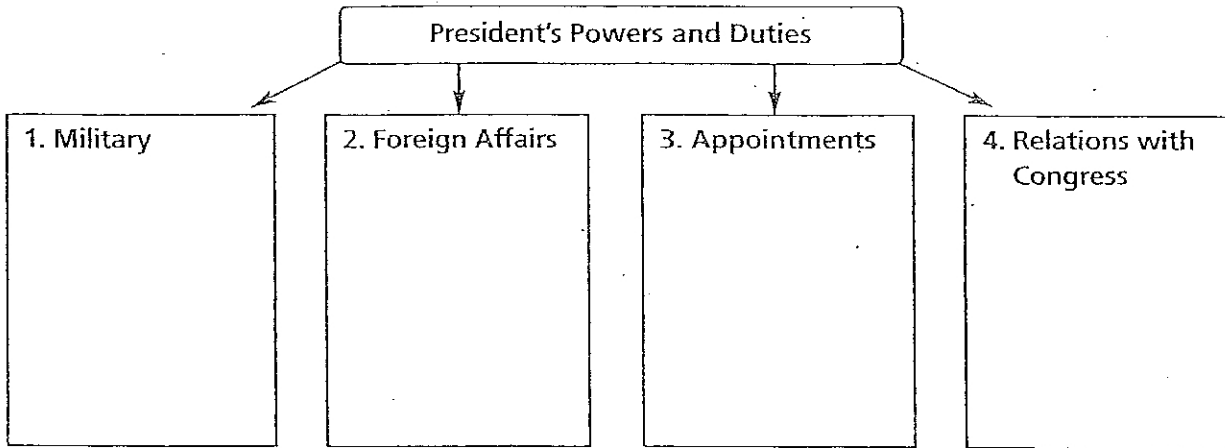
