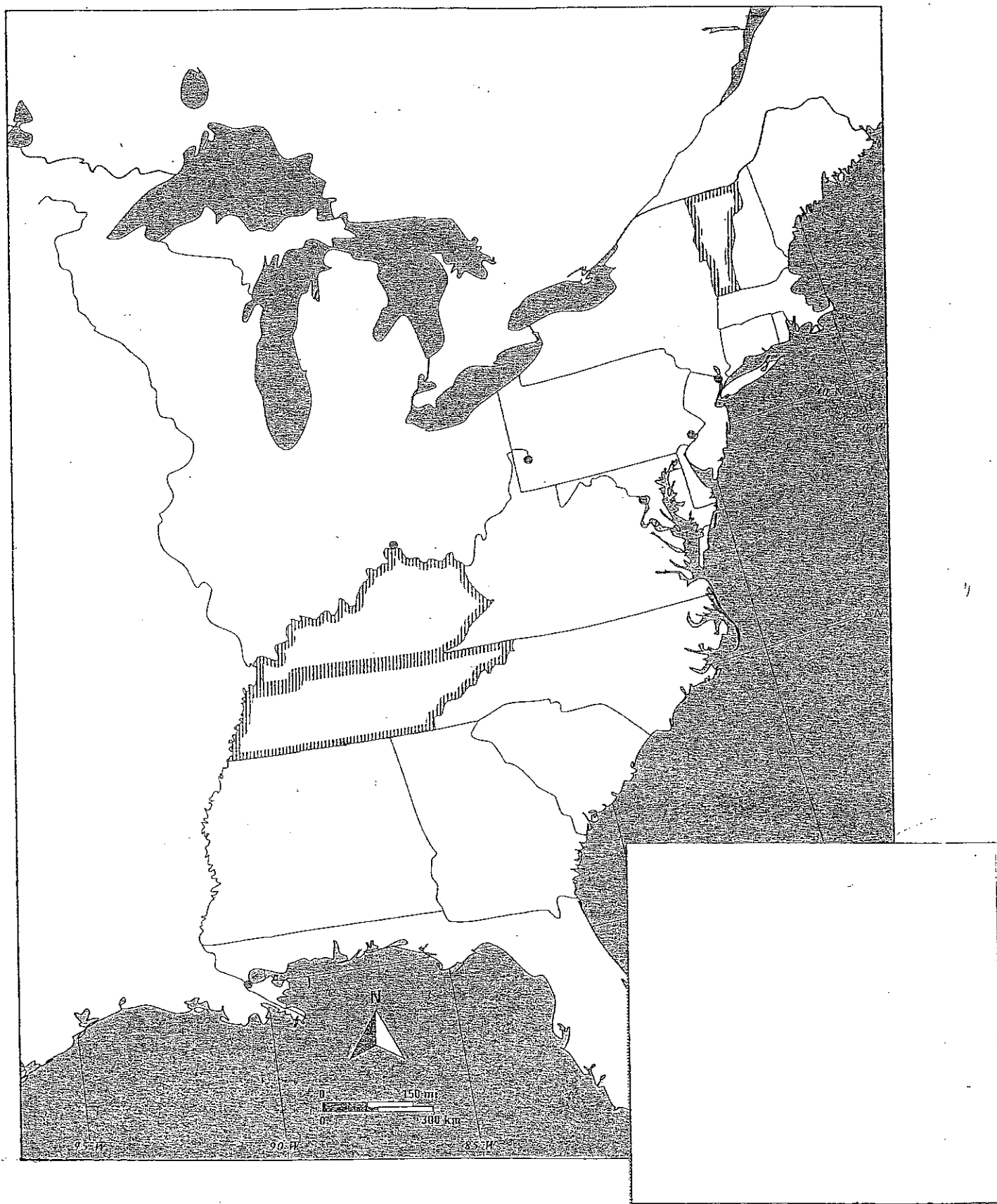


The United States in the Federalist Era
