1803

Marbury v. Madison gives the Supreme Court the power of judicial review.

1803

The United States doubles its size by making the Louisiana Purchase.

Barbary Pirates interfere with U.S. trade

1804-06

Lewis & Clark Expedition

1. H2O route to Asia
2. Map new land and resources
3. Form peaceful relationships with Native Americans.

1807-09

Congress passes the Embargo and Non-Intercourse Acts.

1806

Zebulon Pike

1. starting point of the Red River (SW border of Louisiana Territory)

1811

William Henry Harrison defeats Tecumseh's forces at the Battle of Tippecanoe.

1812 June

The War of 1812 begins between Great Britain and the United States.

July - Tecumseh & Brits defeat Americans

1814

Federalists hold the Hartford Convention to protest the War of 1812.

1813

Americans burn Parliament
Battle of Lake Erie
Battle of Thames

1814

The Treaty of Ghent ends the War of 1812.

Creek War

1815

Andrew Jackson wins the Battle of New Orleans.

Bladensburg Races
Washington, DC attacked and burned
