Who Represents YOU?

(40 points)

This activity is designed to help you find out who your elected officials are. The United States is a democratic republic. A republic is a system of government where people voice their concerns and opinions about various public issues through elected representatives. We vote for these representatives based on how closely their views reflect ours. So, the way that YOU can have a say in how our city, state, and nation is run is by voting! In order to complete this activity, you first need to know your address. Include street address, city, and zip code (just like you see on the mail that comes to your house).
